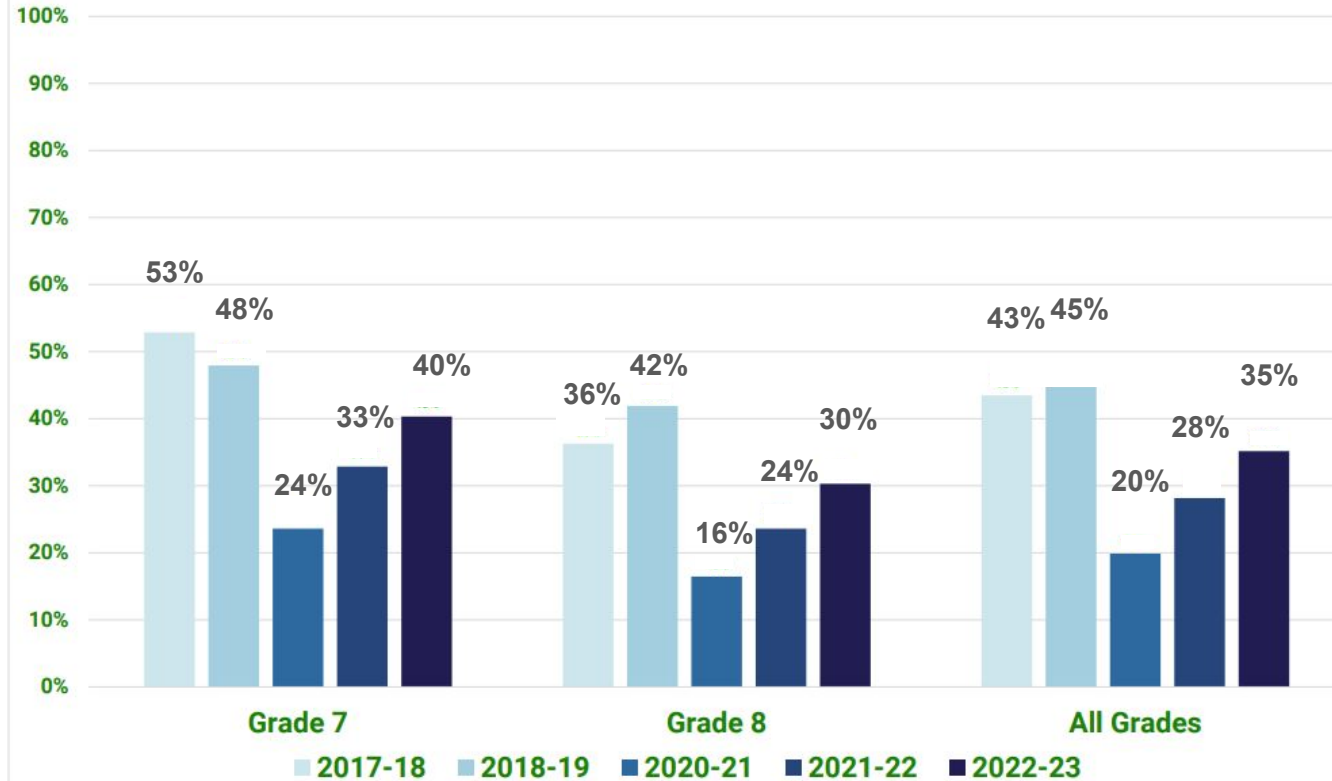

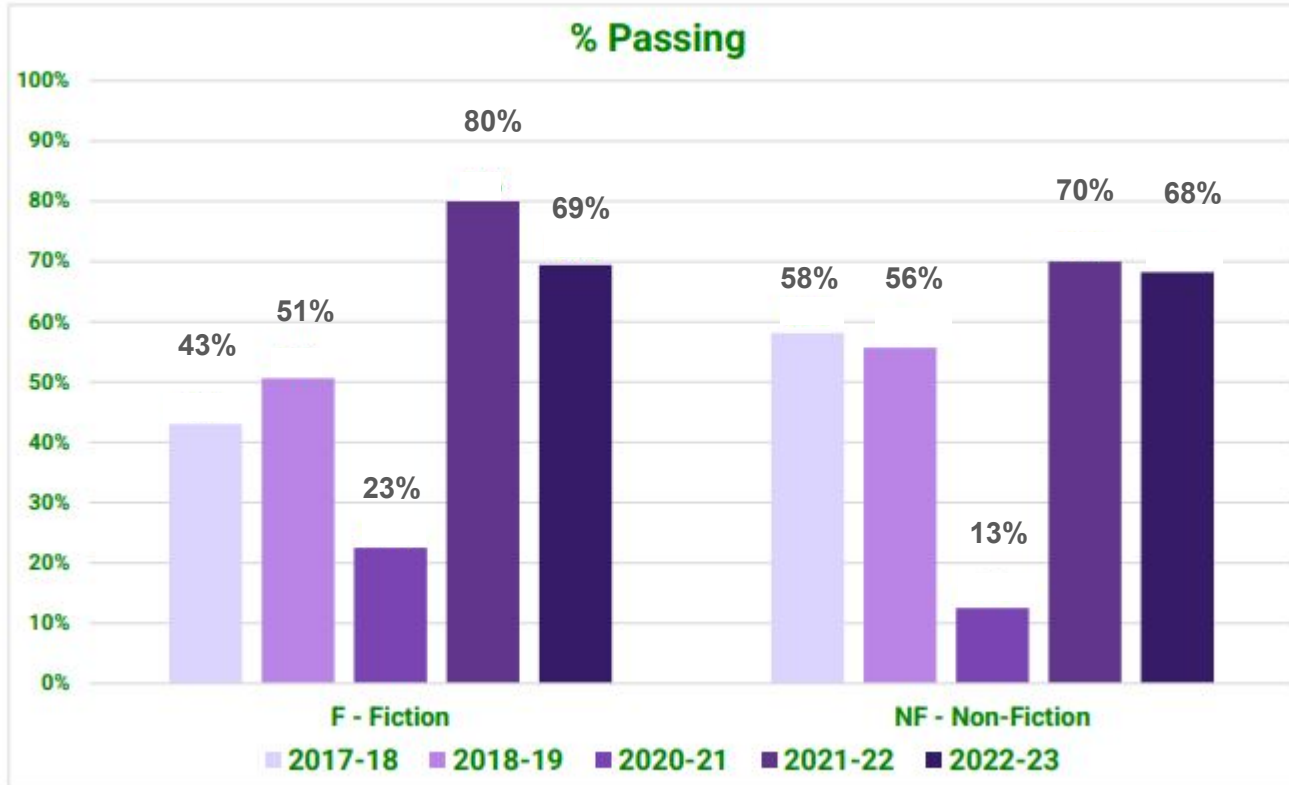
Percent of Possible Points Earned (Algebra I MS)



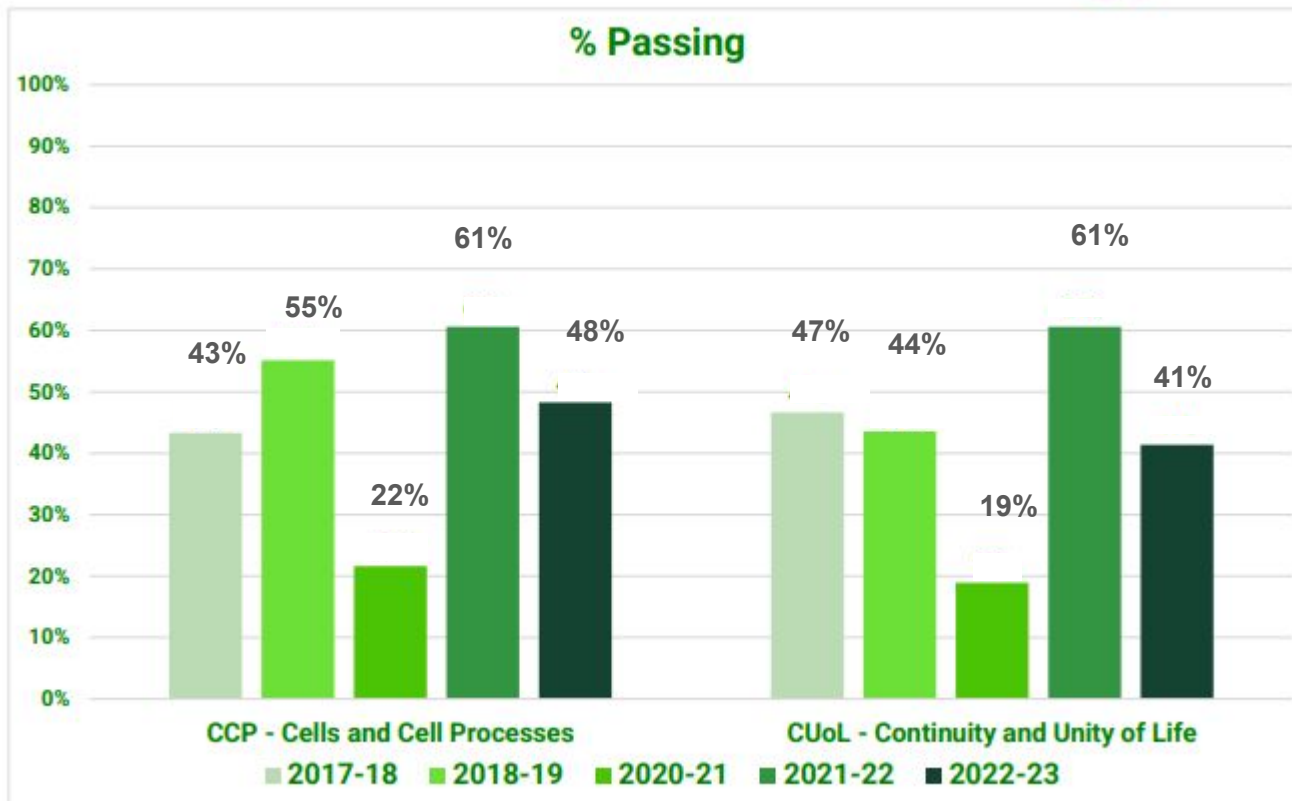
Percent of Possible Points Earned (Algebra I HS)

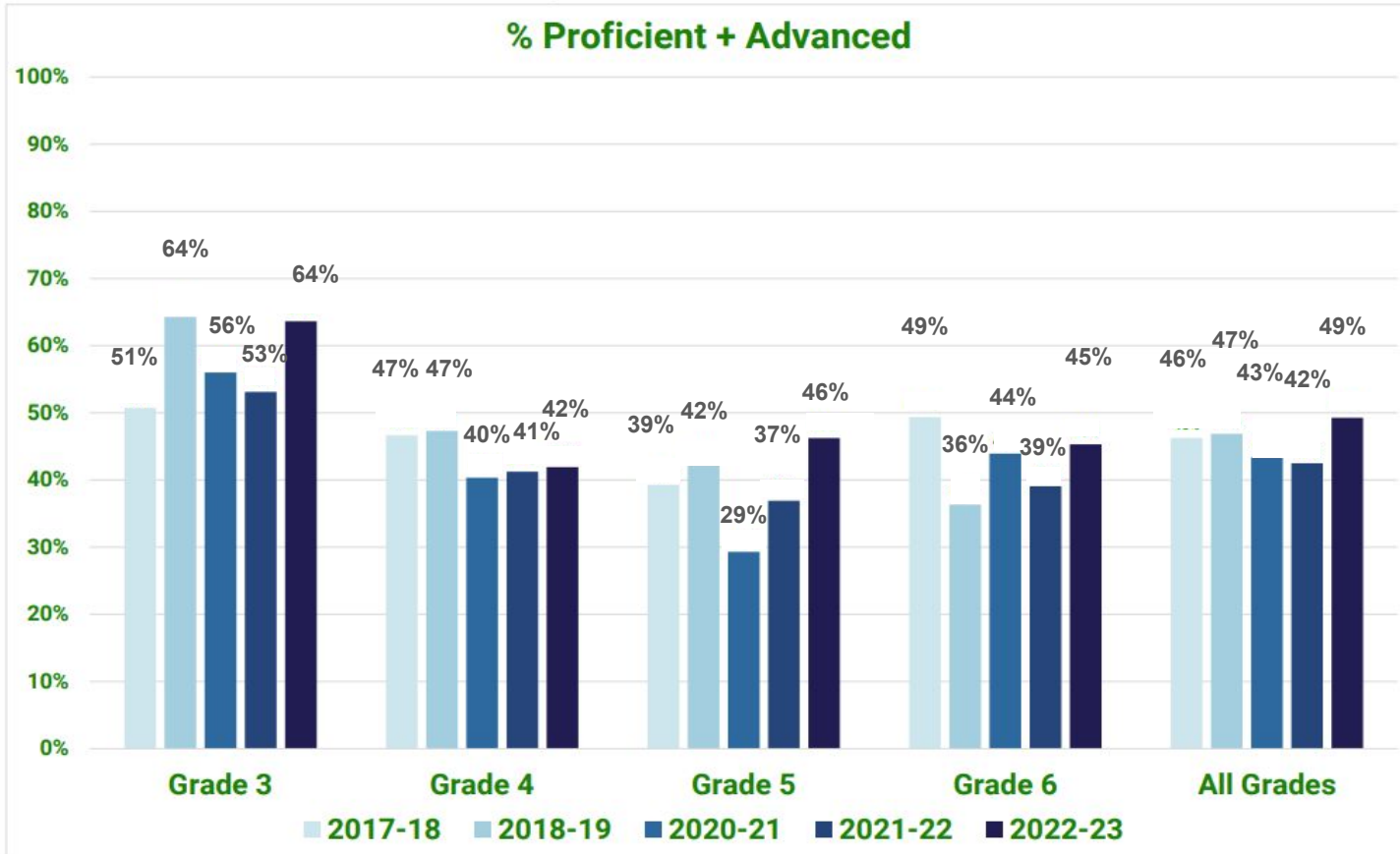

Proficient or Advanced on Pennsylvania State Assessments ⓘ



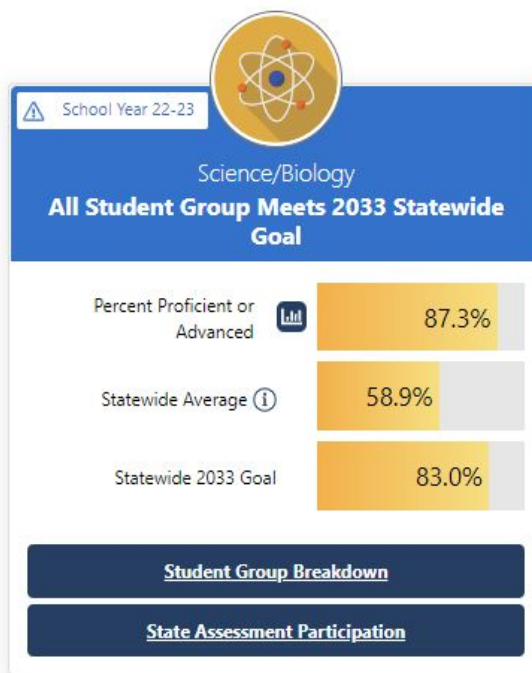
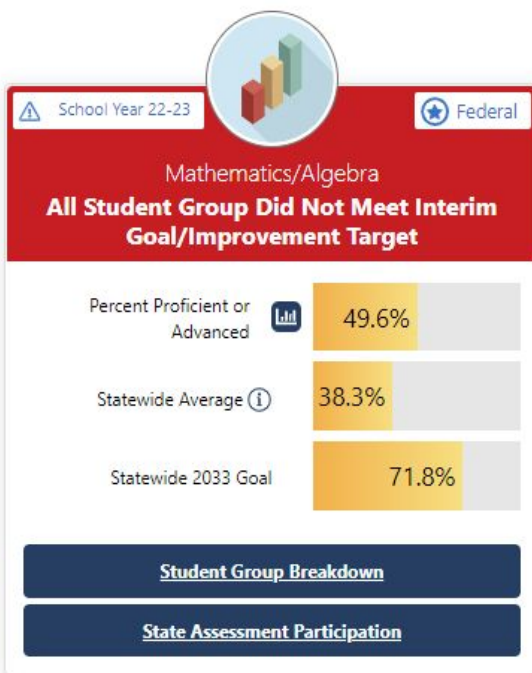
